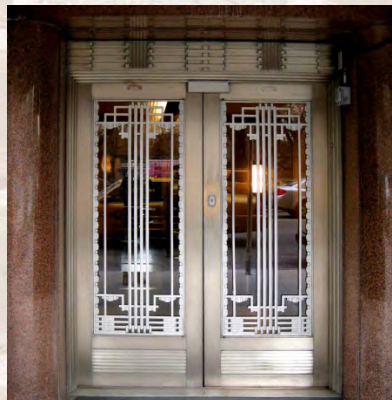
ONGOING AND COMPLETED PROJECTS



*At **Grace Church**, restoration of south transept clerestory windows and interior finishes has been completed. Aisles and chancels will be restored next. This work is being performed in preparation for delivery of a new pipe organ.*



*An extensive exterior restoration project has been completed at **720 Park Avenue**. Work included reconstruction of terraces and of limestone and brick parapets, spandrels, and lintels. The building limestone base was also cleaned.*



*Preparation for the replacement of historic street-level doors at lobby and medical office entryways is underway at **115 Central Park West – The Majestic**.*

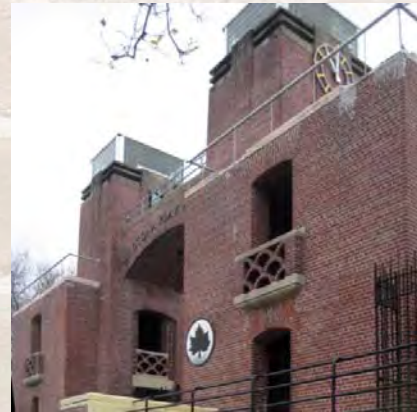

NYC DOB ISSUES

*- The 7th Cycle of the **Façade Inspection and Safety Program** (formerly Local Law 11/98) has been divided into three sub-cycles based on the last digit of the building's block number. The first sub-cycle runs until 2/21/2012. The second sub-cycle has also begun, and runs until 8/21/2012. We are now inspecting buildings and preparing reports for both the first and second sub-cycles.*

*-The **2011 NYC Energy Conservation Code** is now in effect.*
